

Dear Friends:

Happy Family Day Weekend! This is a wonderful holiday to have in February. It's not just another day "off", it's a day to celebrate our



families. So maybe we can do something together! My prayer is that the Good Lord will bless our families with His love; protect us from all danger and harm; free us from anger that leads to division; empower us to forgive as we

have been forgiven; and send us into the world to witness to His love and grace! If we know someone who is alone, maybe include them in your family celebrations! Unfortunately, in Newfoundland, they will be spending the weekend digging out from 4 feet of snow!
