Thought for the Week

The more we empty ourselves, the more room we give God to fill us



#### Dear Friends:

I am still in Newfoundland. After I completed a 14-day quarantine on February 2nd, we were able to bring our mother to our family homestead for 5 days. It was a nice family gathering. No sooner had mom returned to her seniors residence, the entire province was placed in lockdown. In just a few days we went from 5 Covid cases to 300 cases. Most of the cases are from the new Covid strain. We keep praying that this will end. I will return to Niagara when it is safe to do so.

Lent is here. It seems like yesterday that we took down our Christmas decorations. On Ash Wednesday, very few were able to get out to Mass to have ashes marked on their foreheads. We accept where we are, with all the challenges and limitations of this pandemic. The past year feels like we have been through an extended Lent.

Ashes are a reminder that we are creatures, under God's care. And that we are human, made in **the image and likeness of God**. And God who created us, calls us into relationship... and calls us back when we stray. And God knows we all wander and sin and give into temptation.

Today's Gospel scene occurs after Jesus' Baptism. The Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert for **40 days**, with wild beasts... and he was **tempted by Satan**, and angels waited on him. The 1st Sunday of Lent always deals with **TEMPTATION!!!** Unfortunately **temptation is everywhere** and it can be tough to fight. The day we think we're no longer subject to temptation, is the day we should take our pulse, because we're probably dead. All sin is attractive! If it wasn't, we wouldn't be tempted by it.

No matter what our struggles are this Lent with the pandemic, we can still look for ways to grow in our love for God and for each other. Can we work harder at fighting off temptation? Can we give God our sins? Can we increase our personal prayer? Can we exercise more patience with our family members? Can we get out of our own wills and allow God's grace to come deeper into our lives? Can we increase our help for the poor?

This Lent we pray for courage and strength to live **Christ-filled lives!** With Christ at the helm, and at the center of our lives, nothing that the world throws at us will defeat us. He is the conqueror of temptation, the victor over sin, and the strength we need to get through this pandemic storm. Have a grace-filled Lent... one day at a time. Stay safe and Bless!

#### 2nd Sunday of Lent - February 28

God's voice is heard on the mountain in today's Gospel, "This is my Son, the Beloved, listen to him!" Are we attentive to what Jesus is calling us to do? What would listening to Jesus mean at this moment of our lives... this Lent? Maybe he's calling us not only to give up or abstain from something, but to take the money we save, and give it to a soup kitchen, an outreach program, a homeless shelter, or buy canned goods for Project Share. This can certainly be a way of following the voice on the mountaintop and listening to Jesus.

It is always good advice to **listen to Jesus** (even outside of Lent)! But sometimes we have such hectic schedules and competing and distracting voices, that our attention is drawn elsewhere. Times we can't hear Him! **Prayer** is a MUST and so is **silence**. Maybe He is calling

us to find our own private mountain-top, that out of the way place to spend some quiet time to **listen** to Him. We could do that by setting aside a few minutes each day to read and meditate on the scriptures.
