7th Sunday, February 24, 2019

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus continues his *Sermon on the Plain*. He addresses how we are to treat others, if we are truly living the JESUS WAY. Being his disciple is demanding and radical. His words are tough, and they can be totally incomprehensible to our modern day ears. Those who want to live this JESUS WAY, must not only hear the Word of God, but also act on it. It means that bit by bit, we are to attempt those truly difficult things:

Turn the other cheek. Love our enemies, pray for them. Do good to those who hate us. Bless those who curse us. Give to everyone who asks of us, especially those who cannot give in return. Do unto others.

These are the things that change human relationships one by one, things that change the dynamics of our families, our communities and towns, and our world. It's demanding, yet he asks us to try. What great things could happen in our families, in our relationships, in our places of work..., if we really connected the radical love and sacrifice at the Altar with our lives? If I am to work on **one** situation, this week, **what would it** be. Is there one person I could start with? May we spend this week, having heard God's Word and fed by Christ's Body, building bridges instead of walls!

8th Sunday March 3, 2019

Today's Gospel continues Jesus' "Sermon on the Plain". We have a series of three unrelated sayings of Jesus harvested into one place. The three savings are: the blind leading the blind, the speck/log in a person's eye, and a good tree and its fruits. Let's focus on the splinter/plank!!!! Imagine focusing on a splinter in a neighbour's eye, while we have a plank in our own! Jesus used the word "hypocrite" for these people. They are so unaware of their own shortcomings, yet so quick to decry others. These people are negative and hostile, always looking to criticize and find fault. The appealing thing about doing this is that it takes the focus off our own deficiencies, making ourselves feel self-righteous. What's the alternative? Instead of criticizing others, why not care for them? Listen to them. Look at our own faults instead of others. When we are aware of our own weaknesses and strive to overcome them, then we are slow to judge and swift to give the benefit of the doubt. So if we cannot say something good about another person, then it is better to remain silent. As the Season of Lent approaches, this is certainly a great area for all of us to work on!

Prayer, fasting and almsgiving are three traditional spiritual exercises to consider during Lent. Properly approached and utilized, they will indeed



facilitate a change of heart and conversion in our lives. As one writer says, *"prayer, fasting and almsgiving are not the point of Lent, they are the tools of Lent."* They are like three legs of a tripod. *Prayer* nourishes our spirits; *Fasting* disciplines our bodies and puts us in solidarity

with those who suffer from hunger; and *almsgiving* enlarges our hearts as we commit ourselves to the good of others.

Ryan's Bowl Food Program "A Lenten Sacrifice" for St. Pat's! Once again this Lent, we will have a special container at the front and back of the church. All donations will assist a food program in which one of our parishioners, Ken Walsh, has helped initiate in Eastern Uganda. Each day *Ryan's Bowl* feeds upwards to 1200 children at local Catholic Schools. This is the only hot meal these children get each day! Please place your donations into these containers during Lent! If you wish to donate by cheque, please make payable to *Ryan's Bowl Food Program*. "Lord, when did we see you hungry?"

This is a Registered Charity under the CRA, and they issue their own receipts for Income Tax Purposes. Approximately 90% of their funds go directly to the Lunch Program. The other 10% is used for school fees for the most desperate, a school uniform to replace the most tattered, also notebooks and pencils, and in dire cases, to purchase a goat for very needy families.
