

## The Pastor's Pen

#### Dear Friends:

The Second Week of Lent has begun! Our Gospel this Sunday takes us to the *Mount of Transfiguration*. This is a very high mountain, with a long winding road. Only small vehicles can drive up there. The view is spectacular, although the drive up and down is certainly not for the faint of heart! After five trips up and down that mountain, it never got any easier! On the top is a spectacular church, with two side chapels, called *Moses Chapel* and *Elijah Chapel*!



So Jesus takes Peter, James and John up that mountain. And we get a glimpse of Easter! A WOW experience. I think Jesus wanted these three Apostles to witness his glorification. He wanted to give them hope for the coming weeks. Moses and Elijah appear... and Jesus is Transfigured, changed before them! Becomes dazzling white! The disciples get a foretaste of what is to come. A glimpse of Easter! Then we hear

a voice from the cloud, "This is my Son, the Beloved, listen to him!" Pope Francis wrote, "Listen to Jesus and follow him. That's the message of the Transfiguration!"

We have begun the  $2^{nd}$  week of Lent! How are we doing with our Lenten observances? Our promises to ourselves, our promises to God? Is our fasting, abstaining, increase in prayer or almsgiving, going as planned? If not, maybe today, with an Easter experience like this, we can get ourselves back on track. Our Risen Christ is there with us, urging us on, giving us the power and courage to change.

This Gospel can also serve as a call for us to find our own private mountain-top, an *out of the way* place to spend quiet time to listen to Jesus. We can do that by setting aside a few minutes each day to go to our own transfiguration places... to read and meditate on the scriptures. Maybe come to the Stations of the Cross and Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on Friday nights. Maybe increase our frequency in celebrating the transfiguration of the Eucharist at Holy Mass. Wherever we choose to find silence... and alone-time with God, may we be open to a "Wow" experience! And always remain open to conversion and change! Have a blessed week!

#### **Three Traditional Lenten Practices**

Prayer, fasting and almsgiving are three traditional spiritual exercises to consider during Lent. Properly approached and utilized, they will indeed facilitate a change of heart and conversion in our lives. As one writer says, "prayer, fasting and almsgiving are not the point of Lent, they are the tools

of Lent. "They are like three legs of a tripod. Prayer nourishes our spirits; Fasting disciplines our bodies and puts us in solidarity with those who suffer from hunger; and almsgiving enlarges our hearts as we commit ourselves to the good of others.

#### **Church Lighting Problems**

Two months ago, we replaced all the exterior lighting around our property. All lighting is now LED photo-cell (ie. come on at dusk and off at dawn). It has made a great difference at night. The school board has upgraded the lighting on the church side of the school also. Over the past year we have been experiencing some problems with the lighting inside the church.13 years ago we removed all the incandescent lights and replaced them with florescent bulbs. It worked well for a period, but the bulbs don't last. And they're \$75 each, with no warranty. In consultation with three lighting experts, and with all the members of our parish council, it seems this is a good time to replace all the church lighting with suitable LED lights. The good news is, they are guaranteed for 10 years, and we will receive a rebate from the government. Believe it or not, there are some 130 bulbs in our church! We will also have a wall switch installed in the ushers room, and repair the chandelier fixture above the altar. This work will take approximately 4-5 days, and a scaffold will have to be used. so there will be some inconvenience during the week. Start time will be announced soon. (Let there be light, and there was light!)

# Ryan's Bowl Food Program "A Lenten Sacrifice" for St. Pat's!

Once again this Lent, we will have a special container at the front and back of the church. All donations will assist a food program which one of our parishioners, Ken Walsh, has helped initiate in Eastern Uganda. Each day *Ryan's Bowl* feeds upwards to 1200 children at local Catholic Schools. This is the only hot meal these children get each day! Please place your donations into these containers during Lent! If you wish to donate by cheque, please make payable to *Ryan's Bowl Food Program*. "Lord, when did we see you hungry?"

This is a Registered Charity under the Canada Revenue Agency, and they issue their own receipts for Income Tax Purposes. Approximately 90% of their funds go directly to the Lunch Program. The other 10% is used for school fees for the most desperate, a school uniform to replace the most tattered, also notebooks and pencils, and in dire cases, to purchase a goat for very needy families.
