This Sunday's Gospel takes place in *Nazareth*, Jesus' hometown! When Jesus began his public ministry, preaching and teaching in Cana,



Capernaum and Nazareth, people spoke highly of him and were amazed at the *gracious words* he spoke. Things changed quickly when he began to challenge their ideas. They knew they were the chosen people and for Jesus to give them the stories of the prophets Elijah and Elisha going outside to pagans

to work the wonders of God, was very upsetting to his kinfolk. They wanted to hear none of it! What was Jesus doing? Stirring up trouble?
