Pastor's Messaae

Dear Friends:

(Today's bulletin is for January 10th and 17th.

Feast of the Baptism of the Lord- Sunday, January 10th The Season of Christmas officially ends on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. And that's what we celebrate this Sunday. Tomorrow we will enter into *Ordinary Time*, until Ash Wednesday (Feb 17). This Sunday we will hear Mark's Gospel. After Jesus was baptized, the Holy Spirit descended in the form of a dove, and the voice of the Father was heard, "This is my Son, the Beloved, with whom I am well pleased!" After Jesus was baptized (age of 30), he began his public ministry. He was empowered by the Spirit to begin the mission of the Father! This is a great feast to look at our own baptism. If we call ourselves Christian then we must be Christians in visible and concrete ways. We ask for the courage this day to join Jesus in the Jordan River, and seek ways that furthers the Kingdom of God. Am I faithful to my baptismal promises? Do people know that I am a Christian by how I live and act and love? Is where I live, work and play, more human, more sacred, more loving, more Christ-like, because I am there? And of course, the big question is: Can God say out loud about you and me, "This is my beloved son/daughter, with whom I am well pleased?" Baptism means many things: a cleansing, repentance, an adoption, an affirmation, an initiation, but may we never forget, that at our Baptism, we took on the identity as a CHILD OF GOD! May we spend the rest of our lives, living up to that identity.

2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time- January 17th

The readings for this Sunday have to do with God calling! God calls Samuel in the first reading, and we get Samuel's response, "Speak Lord for your servant is listening." Our Psalm proclaims, "Here I am Lord; I come to do your will!" Our Gospel is a beautiful scene where two men ask Jesus "where are you staying?" And Jesus answers, "Come and see!" Simon and Andrew follow Jesus, and their lives are changed forever! Two thousand years later Jesus calls each of us too! What is your calling? What is my calling? The answer is simple: we are called to serve God. The answer is a mystery, the mystery of our lives. We pray for the grace and courage to be attentive to God's call in our lives. We pray for the courage to follow Him, so that when He calls we will freely respond, "Speak Lord, your servant is listening."
