

Dear Friends,

Today is the feast of *The Baptism of the Lord*. In today's Gospel, we jump ahead 30 years... from the Manger to the Jordan! In the Gospel, we hear John the Baptist telling Jesus, "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?" But Jesus said he wanted to *fulfill all righteousness!*



Why was Jesus baptized, when he didn't need it? He so loved us, wanted to be so close to his people, that he *chose* to get down into the waters to be baptized by John! What a God we have! John was faithful to his vocation as the last prophet of the Old Testament and first prophet of the New Testament! He prepared the way of the

Lord.... and now prepared Jesus for his ministry. After his baptism, the Holy Spirit descended upon Jesus in the form of a dove, and we hear the voice of the Father from Heaven, "*This is my Son, the Beloved, with whom I am well pleased!*" Only after Jesus was baptized did his public ministry begin. We'll hear all the great stories and miracles of Jesus' ministry throughout the year.

Today's feast is an occasion to look at our own baptism. Am I faithful to my baptismal promises? Am I a model disciple... a model servant... a faithful member of the *People of God*? Being a member of the *Body of Christ*, the Church, does everyone out there know that I am a baptized Christian by how I live and act and love? Where I live and work and socialize... is it more human, more sacred, more loving, more Christ-like, because I am there? These are questions worth pondering. And of course, the ultimate question is: Can God say out loud about you and me, "*This is my beloved son/daughter, with whom I am well pleased?*" If not, maybe it's time for a good old Christian renewal! We enter once again into the Church's Liturgical Season of Ordinary Time until Lent! Maybe we can turn our lives into something Extra-Ordinary! God bless!
