

# Fourth Sunday January 28, 2018

February will be here this week! That means that Spring will be here next month! Stay positive! Don't forget that the little bulbs are coming to life under the snow! The word, *February* comes from the Latin, *februum-februa*, which means *to purify*, *to cleanse*, *to atone*. So I guess we each have our work cut out for us this month! Remember, Lent begins

# Fifth Sunday February 4, 2018

In this Sunday's Gospel. Jesus cures Peter's mother-in-law from a fever. We all love miracles, healings, good news. One of the most sacred things we do as Christians and as Catholics is **pray for those who are**

## The Presentation of the Lord
