I hope everyone was able to make the best of this Christmas Season. We were forced to make many changes in our plans and traditions. With God's help, this virus will be brought to an end.

By the time you receive this bulletin, it will be a New Year! Happy 2021! So much has happened since our last publication. We have been in a lockdown since Boxing Day. That means that only 10 people can be present in the church at any given time. We are celebrating Mass in the church on Monday to Friday at 8:00 AM. You must call the parish office to preregister. For the time being we are celebrating Mass at 5:00 PM on Saturday and also 11:00 AM on Sunday. Again, only 10 people can be present. Should there be any changes in the schedule, they will be posted on the parish website. These are very difficult times, and we do everything we can to remain safe. (Private Masses will be celebrated by our priests to fulfill the Mass Intentions that you requested).

Today, January 3rd, is the **Feast of the Epiphany** (*Little Christmas*). *Epiphany* means manifestation [*to show; make known; to reveal.*] This
