Dear Friends,

Today's Gospel continues from last week. Jesus is in his hometown of *Nazareth*. His townsfolk spoke highly of him and were amazed at the



gracious words he spoke. Then things changed! "Is this not Joseph's son?", someone shouted! Jesus challenges his kin. They knew they were the chosen people! And they weren't open to anyone else being recipients of God's grace and salvation! Jesus, in all his wisdom, reminds them of the stories of the

prophets Elijah and Elisha who went outside the Israelites to the Gentiles to work the wonders of God. He mentioned specifically a widow at Zarephath, and Naaman the Syrian, who were healed!
