


14th Sunday [Matthew 11: 25-30] July 9, 2017

Construction Updates

(1) We received approval from the City of Niagara Falls last week, to have our **drainage system** replaced. Currently, all the rain water from



our Hall, Garage and Drive-Way is going through piping underneath the subfloors in the parish hall and into the City sewers. Too often, it is backing up in our hall! We have been working with the City for some time, and finally this will receive the attention it needs. Because of the substantial work that will have to be done on our

property, with two new catch basins, and a large pipe across Victoria Avenue into the storm drain, we will have to split the costs with the City. Our share will be in the vicinity of \$28-30,000.

(2) Another project that needed attention was the re-pointing of the stone above the front windows in the Parish Hall, and also the limestone base. We had experienced some leaking during the last few rain falls, so this needed to be addressed immediately. As of this week, it has been completed by stone-worker, Frank Cook. (\$2500.00) (3) Five years ago we replaced all the first floor windows in the Rectory. This year we will have to replace the 14 upstairs windows, and one window in the old parish office. Quotes are being received, and they will hopefully be installed at the end of the summer, early September! (\$8500). Thanks for your ongoing generosity to the parish which makes these repairs possible!
