

Jesus is testing his disciple's faith! His compassionate heart says that all the people gathered on the mountain, must be fed, not only spiritually, but physically! Jesus uses what a little boy has, five barley loaves and two fish, to feed 5000 people. We are now the disciples whom Jesus tells to feed the people. We must bring what we have to the Lord and allow him to transform it into more and better! World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly

Sunday, July 28, 2024, is the 4th World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. The theme chosen by the Holy Father, "Do not abandon me in old age" (Ps 71:9), refers to the bitter reality of the lives of many elderly people who often live in solitude and are victims of the throwaway culture. The celebration of the Day enhances the charisms of grandparents and elderly people and their contribution to the life of the Church. Pope Francis writes: "God never abandons his children. Not even when age advances and strength declines, when hair turns white and the social role diminishes, when life becomes less productive and risks seeming useless. He does not look at appearances and does not disdain choosing those who too many appear irrelevant. He does not discard any stone, indeed, the "oldest" are the secure base on which the "new" stones can lean to build the spiritual edifice together." Let's do something special with our grandparents or with our elders this week.

St. Anne and St. Joachim

Friday, July 26th is the Feast of Sts. Anne and Joachim, Grandparents of Jesus. This feast reminds grandparents of their responsibility to establish a tone for generations to come: They must make the traditions live and offer them as a promise to little children. The feast has a message for the younger generation as well. It reminds the young that elders' greater perspective, depth of experience, and appreciation of life's profound rhythms are all part of a wisdom not to be taken lightly or ignored.
