

Dear Friends:




Joy and happiness abound in all the readings today! Our faith is not meant to be a dark and gloomy thing! There's absolutely nothing in the entire bible that's bad news! Whatever we're going through in our lives: grief, family illness, aging parents, ill health, trouble with a child, marital problems, personal struggles..., we are assured that we have a comforting God who is with us! He cares about

every aspect of our lives. Let God speak to us wherever we are right now. He assures us that we're not alone, *I am with you always!*

In our first reading, Isaiah speaks of a caring God who gives us prosperity and wealth. He tells of the people being nursed at the breast of Jerusalem, carried in God's arms. How tender.
