## 18th and 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time (July 31st and August 7th)

### Dear Friends:

Our readings for the next two Sundays, particularly the Gospel, deal with storing up treasures in heaven. This Sunday, July 31st, Jesus warns us about greed, and about gathering up an abundance of possessions here on earth. It takes our focus off what's really important! Life is beautiful, when it is lived with God. That is the Good News of Jesus Christ. Paul tells us in his Letter to the Colossians that we are to *seek what is above*, not what is of the earth. He reminds us that our baptism was a death with Christ to the material world and a rising with Him to the Life of the Spirit. Next Sunday, August 7th, we will hear Jesus telling us that we must always be ready, *for the Son of Man is coming at an unexpected hour!* Good advice for us to be ready at all times! Because the Lord is returning. How should we prepare? Not just by looking busy, but by being busy! Busy about God's work!

Maybe for the next two weeks we could do some personal reflection on these Gospels. What **are** the priorities in my life? Family? Things? Job? Spiritual Life? Do things take precedence over people? Do activities take precedence over God? Do I hoard things while so many people lack for these very things? Am I generous toward those who struggle to survive... who struggle to put food on the table? Maybe we can open our hearts deeper during August to Project Share, St. Vincent de Paul, to our School Clothing and Supplies Drive, to our Breakfast Program, or some local charity. As one saint said, "The only things we can take to heaven with us are the things we gave to the poor!" Did Jesus not say, "...give to the poor and you'll have treasure in heaven!" May you have a blessed August month, and may others benefit from our generosity! Many blessings. *Fr. Gerard*
