11th Sunday June 13, 2021

Jesus tells two parables this Sunday: one about *scattered seed* and one about a tiny *mustard seed*. These parables explain what the Kingdom of God is like! We plant seeds and we do our best to water, weed and cultivate, but as today's Gospel says, so much of the growing takes place without us knowing how! God's hand is in everything, and God is the author of all change and growth! We too need to do our work with the plants, and also in God's Kingdom. If we allow God's hand and God's power to work in and through our lives, what a difference we can make.

The mustard seed is the smallest of all seeds. It literally grows to be a tree which attracts numerous birds. God's kingdom works in the same way. It starts from the smallest seeds of faith in our hearts. When we are receptive to God's word, and allow it to be cultivated in our hearts and souls, a transformation takes place from within. God can still change us by his grace! If we're in a garden this week... look closely at the plants. Look at the work that must be done to produce the results. Then look at our own lives, and ask, "What still needs to be done in ME" or "what do I still need to do, to make the Kingdom of God more of a reality?

12th Sunday June 20, 2021

Today is Father's Day! May God bless our fathers, living and deceased, with an abundance of life and joy.

Today's Gospel takes place on the *Sea of Galilee*. Jesus and his disciples were in a boat crossing to the other side, when a storm came up! Some of the disciples were fishermen.
