June 15, 2025 - Most Holy Trinity

As Catholics we have many rituals, one being how we begin and end all prayers: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit! It's one of the first things we teach our children, how to bless themselves by making the Sign of the Cross... the sign of God's eternal love for us! We invoke the *Holy Trinity* (Three Persons in One God). The Sign of the Cross is a strong affirmation of our faith. Whether morning or evening prayer, the Mass, the Rosary, or grace before meals, we always begin and end with this Trinitarian blessing. It defines who we are, to whom we belong. We are God's children, whom God loves. forgives and empowers! On this feast we celebrate our God, and the intimate relationship between Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We have a Father who loves us unconditionally, and his Son who made this love concrete by becoming one of us and dying for us and bringing God's forgiveness to us, and we have the Holy Spirit, who is God dwelling within us, empowering us. The unity within the Trinity is the model placed before us today. The Three Divine Persons work together for the salvation of all. And we must work together for the good of all. May everything we do and say be guided by the Holy Trinity!

June 22, 2025 Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

The Gospel today is the *Feeding of the Crowds*. This Gospel really shows us the compassion of Jesus. It was late in the evening and the crowds hadn't eaten. The disciples wanted to send them away. They only had 5 loaves and 2 fish. But Jesus took what little they had, and "he looked up to heaven, *blessed* and *broke* them, and *gave* them to the disciples to set before the crowd!" And there was plenty for everyone. He *took*, *blessed*, *broke and gave*! These are all actions. These are the same actions we hear at the Last Supper, and also during the Emmaus Supper on Easter evening. And of course, at every celebration of the Eucharist! Took, blessed, broke and gave. Maybe this week we can find some creative ways to connect the Eucharist to our daily lives. Being fed by the Body and Blood of Christ is not only our spiritual nourishment, food for the soul, but it also calls for action! We must go forth and BE CHRIST for others. Never underestimate what we can do by small acts of kindness: a kind word or gesture, an act of charity, a friendly visit, a call. If we each do one kind action this week in honour of Christ, what a difference we can make, at school, work, in our families, in our neighbourhood.
