Sunday, June 17th-11th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells two parables: one about *scattered seed* and one about a tiny *mustard seed*. These parables were told to explain what the Kingdom of God is like! We plant seeds and we do our best to water,



weed and prune, but as today's Gospel says, so much of the growing takes place without us knowing how! **God's hand is in everything**, and God is the author of all change and growth! We too need to do our work with the plants, and also in God's Kingdom. If we allow

God's hand and God's power to work in and through our lives, what a difference we can make.

The mustard seed is the smallest of all seeds. It literally grows to be a tree which attracts numerous birds. God's kingdom works in the same way. It starts from the smallest seeds of faith in our hearts. When we are receptive to God's word, and allow it to be cultivated in our hearts and souls, a transformation takes place from within. God can still change me and you by his grace!

If we are out around a garden this week... look at the plants. Look at the work that must be done to produce the results. Then look at our own lives, and ask, "What still needs to be done in ME" or "what do I still need to do, to make the Kingdom of God more of a reality?"

Sunday, June 24th- Nativity of John the Baptist

We hear much about John during Advent. He was *named by God!* And his name means, 'God is gracious'. In the birth of John and in the birth of Jesus we see the grace of God breaking forth into a world broken by sin and without hope. John's miraculous birth to elderly parents shows the mercy and favour of God in preparing his people for the coming of the Messiah. John's life was fueled by one burning passion: to point others to Jesus Christ and to the coming of his Kingdom. His message was similar to that of the Old Testament prophets who chided the people of God for their unfaithfulness and who tried to awaken true repentance in them. John declared of Jesus, "He must increase and I must decrease. I baptize you with water, he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit!" John awakened people's interest, unsettled them from their complacency, and aroused in them enough good will to recognize and receive Christ when he came.

What is the significance of John the Baptist and his message for our lives? All of us have a prophetic call. That is, to listen to the word of God and to put our heart, soul, body, imagination and intelligence, into understanding what that word means for our time. Everything in our lives has to point to Christ. Do we make our lives an offering to God? Maybe a good week to renew the offering of our lives to God and give God thanks for his mercy and favour towards us.


