

Sunday, June 23rd - 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel, we have a frightening scene on the Sea of Galilee. A storm came up while Jesus and his disciples were crossing to the other side. Many of them were fishermen. But they were terrified when they saw the storm. They knew the dangers. Their boat was swamped. Jesus was sleeping on a cushion. In fear, they woke him. Then Jesus rebuked the wind and stilled the sea. Then he questioned why they were afraid... and he even questioned their faith. It was then they recognized the power of God working through him.
