

### FROM THE PASTOR

#### Dear Friends:

Welcome officially to Summer! This week our children will be finishing school! May God bless and protect them during the summer break. And may God bless our teachers and principals and support staff with a relaxing and fun summer. After this week, we will be publishing our Sunday Bulletin every second week.



This past week we had our Carmelite Provincial Chapter at Mount Carmel with some 120 Carmelites from around North America, Peru, Mexico, El Salvador and Rome. It was great to see so many of our Carmelites, young and old! During the week we had an evening of remembrance as we approach the 50th Anniversary of the Mount

Carmel Fire of 1967. We were blessed to have our Mayor join us, along with our Fire Chief, and a Superintendent from Niagara Regional Police. We Carmelites expressed our thanks to the City, Police and Fire Departments and to the citizens of Niagara for their support and care during that dark period in our Canadian Carmelite history. This past week, our first Monastery Cellars Ice Wine rolled off the shelves at Mount Carmel Gift Shop! Our Carmelites will be planting five more acres of grapes across Stanley Avenue very shortly.

From our parish survey, one of the areas that you wanted addressed was something for our young people! So we have begun to put together a youth team, and work is already in progress to develop some type of youth ministry and activity for the Fall season. If you would like to be part of the planning, please let the parish office know as soon as possible. We are also looking to develop fun programs for our seniors. So stay posted! Let's not just talk about it, let's do it!!!

We received approval from the City of Niagara Falls this week, to have our drainage system replaced. Currently, all the rain water from our



drains is going through piping underneath the subfloors in the parish hall and into the City sewers. Too often, it is backing up in our hall! We have been working with the City for some time, and finally this will receive the attention it needs. Because of the substantial work that will have to be done on our property, with two new

catch basins, and a large pipe across Victoria Avenue, we will have to split the costs with the City. Our share will be in the vicinity of \$28-30,000. The other project that needs to be completed in the summer is the re-pointing of the stone above the front windows in the Parish Hall, and also the limestone base. We have experienced some leaking during the last few rain falls, so this needs to be addressed immediately.

#### **TODAY'S GOSPEL**

We receive many challenges and much encouragement in today's Gospel. Jesus sends out his disciples and assures them of his presence . "Do not be afraid," he says. Go out and proclaim the Good News from the rooftops;

bring everything into the light. It will not always be popular, or not always warmly received. But do not let that prevent you from **DOING** the Gospel! Our call is no different.
