June 26, 2022 – 13th Sunday

Today's Gospel is about discipleship and commitment to Jesus. When God calls us to follow, he gives us the grace and strength to put aside everything that prevents us from doing His will. Loyalty to Jesus requires sacrifice, **letting go of my will for God's will**. In today's

Gospel a **would-be disciple** responded to Jesus' call by saying, **first let me go and bury my father!** (take care of him until he dies.) Jesus didn't mean that we should refuse to care for others, especially our parents. His shocking response made clear that God must **always come first in our lives**. If we love God above all, then everything else will fall into its proper place.

Jesus surprised his disciples and he challenges us... by saying that **we must not look back** (*keep our hands to the plow*) and keep our focus on the goal set for our lives, full happiness and union with God. Isn't that what we all desire? A plowman who looks back causes his furrow to be crooked. Likewise, if we keep **looking back** to what we left behind, our path in following God will likely go off course and we'll miss what God has in store for us. Am I resolved to keep my eyes fixed on Jesus and to "stay the course" in following him to the end? That's the question! With Jesus, nothing should be wishy-washy! If we catch ourselves straddling fences, take that leap of faith, and come back onto his radical path. Have a good week, and a Happy Canada Day this Friday!



July 3, 2022 14th Sunday

In the Gospel this Sunday, Jesus sends out 72 disciples in pairs to do his work, and announce the Kingdom. They returned **filled with joy** at the things they did in his name. How can we not plug

into that joy and excitement? Here's a good exercise for us this week: take a pen and paper and write down (in the almost obsolete *cursive* writing) all the things we did in God's name this past week... that would have given God **JOY**? Would there be anything? Hopefully so! Then write a list of things we **will do** for God this coming week! Because 2000 years later, we're still being sent to announce the Kingdom. Our lives and actions must breathe the Kingdom! Just as the disciples brought joy and peace to the places they went, we must also be **people of peace and joy**! This can defeat evil, turn mourning into dancing! There's lots out there that need defeating! Even things in our own lives! Being a child of God, created in God's image, being Baptized, **means we are to love** in a special way and be joyful. The Resurrection happened! Our role is to live it!!! Let's spread joy this week!
