Today is Laetare Sunday, the Fourth Sunday of Lent! The Entrance Antiphon for today's Mass prays, "*Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exult and be satisfied at her consoling breast.*" This is a Sunday of joy. Lent is half over, and the mood of this Sunday is one of hope and rejoicing that Easter is near.

Our reading from Joshua, recounts the celebration of the Passover in the Promised Land by Joshua and those who had been in the desert for 40 years. We can only imagine the joy and celebrations! The second reading from Corinthians, reminds us what God has brought about by Jesus' death on the cross: RECONCILIATION!!!... an atoning sacrifice for the sins of the world.




Our Gospel is from Luke, *The Prodigal Son*! A powerful parable. It teaches us that God is like that kind and understanding Father, always with open arms welcoming us back when we have strayed. The son who asked for his inheritance, certainly

represents all of us, when we cut ourselves off from God, through sin. The good news is, God's love and mercy is able to reach every prodigal son and daughter! All of us. God can restore us again!
