Last week we had a new Expansion Tank installed to the boiler system in our parish hall. The diaphragm in the old one had deteriorated. Hopefully this will remedy the many problems we experienced during this winter. Many thanks to Castle Plumbing for their wonderful service, and good price. As you may have

noticed, we had a new Refrigerator installed in our Parish Kitchen. It is a good commercial quality with two sliding glass doors. The company (Advantage) gave us a \$500 discount. (It helps when you celebrate the wedding for the owner!!!) Hopefully in the near future we will be approved for a rebate program to replace the incandescent lighting in the parish hall, and the fluorescent tube lighting in the stairwells. The lighting in the gym, church, and exterior buildings have all been replaced with LED lighting. This past week we had Savaria Elevator Company here to replace the hydraulic hose in the church lift. Many thanks to you, our faithful parishioners, for making these projects and updates possible.

Happy Mother's Day to all! A special prayer will be prayed for our mothers, living and deceased, at all Masses this Sunday.

Today our **Diocese of St. Catharines** begins Phase One of her *Cathedral Appeal* (see below). The interior is desperately in need of repair and revitalization. Our Parish of St. Patrick has been assessed, and asked to raise \$16,000 (3% of last year's income) between May and November of this year. There is a brief appeal letter that will be read at each Mass, and also brochures and envelopes will be distributed after all Masses. The Cathedral is our Mother Church, and each parish must do her part to take care of our Mother! May we open our hearts to this need.

Today is *World Day of Prayer for Vocations*! We must do everything we can to foster good solid vocations to the Married Life, Single Life, Religious Life and the Priesthood. This is also known as Good Shepherd Sunday! Sometimes, as hard as we try, we just cannot get to Mass on time. Things happen. Traffic happens. Trains happen. That's normal and natural. Especially for parents with small children. If for some reason we



are late, then maybe consider using the main entrance of the church (back). Then wait for an appropriate time to be seated. If we enter the side doors after Mass begins, please <u>wait in the</u> <u>entrance</u> for an appropriate time to be seated. This can be done during that

brief period after the Opening Prayer, and before the Scripture Readings are proclaimed. We can also enter during a hymn, but never while God's Word is being proclaimed.

When receiving Holy Communion in your hand, it must be consumed immediately. Please place it in your mouth while in front of the priest or Eucharistic Minister. We must never walk away with the Blessed Sacrament in our hand. Also, if you need a gluten-free Host, please let the priest or one of the Eucharistic Ministers know **before** Mass.

I invite our **young people** to consider living a life dedicated to God as a Priest or Religious. I invite everyone in St. Patrick Parish to pray for vocations and just as important, to **encourage vocations**.
