The Pastor's Pen

Dear Friends,



After the sadness of Pope Francis' passing on Easter Monday, there was great surprise and jubilation at the election of a new Pope on May 8, 2025, after less than 24 hours in the Conclave. Cardinal Robert Prevost will be known as Pope Leo XIV, the

first Pope ever born in the United States... an Augustinian Friar from the South-Side of Chicago. He spent over 20 years ministering in Peru. Welcome to Pope Leo. We hold him deep in prayer as he begins his Papal Ministry.

In today's Gospel, on this 5th Sunday of Easter, we have a scene from the Last Supper. Jesus is at Table with his friends for one last time. After Judas had departed, Jesus said, *I give you a new commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you.* These words and this command should be embedded deeply into our Christian hearts and souls! The basic command for Christian life. "By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."



As I have loved you? How has he loved us? The greatest love story of all human history! Imagine, God became one of us. Took on our flesh and blood, to save us. He held nothing back. Even

nailed to a cross for me and you. From that dark Good Friday, all that is Christian stems. All love stems! We certainly know how Jesus loved us. But how do we **love one another?** This is not a gentle invitation, **this is a command from Jesus!**

My prayer is that we will take some time this week to reflect on this Gospel, and ask ourselves, how are we doing as His disciples! Maybe we can renew our commitment to follow this commandment of love. This command calls for a way of life, modeled on Jesus' life. I'm sure if we look into our hearts, we will find things there that are not in keeping with Jesus' command. Maybe its pettiness, negativism, self-centeredness, judging, un-forgiveness, jealousy, racism, sexism, ageism, greed, anger! Whatever we may find in our hearts and souls that is contrary to Jesus' love, maybe we can do something about it this week! God has enough grace and mercy for everyone to change! Have a loving week!
