
renew our devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

To be a follower, to be Christian... is to live united with Christ.

We get ourselves in big trouble if we separate ourselves from Him or try to make it through this life on our own. We are called to make Christ's message real in the world, to be witnesses to the Resurrection. We are to bring His Love out into the world, and transform the world with His Presence. We can only do that in as much as we are intimately connected to Him! Maybe this week, we can spend time reflecting on how well am I grafted to the True Vine? Do I have an intimate union with Christ? If so, is this evident to others? What can I do this week to bear fruit for the Gospel? Happy pruning, weeding and trimming!

#### 6th Sunday of Easter

Today's 2<sup>nd</sup> reading from 1 *John*, and the Gospel from John 15 speak about the command to Love. John reminds us that God has first loved us. He has showered His Mercy on us, and has chosen us to be the recipients of his love. In the Gospel we hear that we are to *love one another* as Jesus

loves us! And look what he did out of love for me and you! He laid down his life! We are called to that same sacrificial love. And the Mercy of God is always available for us. God does not give up on us even when we have not loved as we should.
