# Dear Friends,

November is here! Happy All Saints Day! We get the opportunity to celebrate this Solemnity on a Sunday! I always love reading the lives of the saints! They give us great examples of people who emptied themselves to allow God's plan to work in them. They are not plaster or plastic statues of unreal people in pious poses. They are **real people** from every walk of life who met the challenge of Christianity and conquered.

We all have our favorite saints... but what draws us to them? I think it's a big mistake if we focus on their supernatural powers, as if they were a Superman-woman, or Super-Hero! We must be very careful we don't turn them into plastic, fantasy figurines, whose lives are nice heroic stories... but impossible for us to follow. The saints were and are real people who had to fight the same battles and demons we fight, in order to serve God. They had the courage to live the sacrifice of Christ in their lives, and to make the love of God real in the world. And that's our call also!

Some of them had bad tempers, like Sts. Jerome and Paul. Some had to recover their spiritual lives after giving in to sin, like Sts. Ignatius Loyola, Francis of Assisi and Augustine. Some were courageous and stood for



the faith when every fiber of their body was terrified at what would happen to them, like Sts. Agnes, and Ignatius of Antioch. My favorite is **St. Therese**, who found God in the ordinary everyday activities of her life. That's probably why I am attracted to her... I don't look for God up in the sky, but right here in the everyday as I struggle with the tasks and

temptations and demands of daily life.

The saints **are** real, normal human beings like you and me! They were fully human, in that they allowed **the best of their humanity** to dominate their lives. As human, we are both physical and spiritual. The saints allow the **spiritual aspect** of their lives to be integrated into the physical. They were and are the best of us. As we honour the saints, we recognize that they are with God and we can call upon their intercession. We ask them to pray for us, and to help us in the struggles of our lives. Some days I invoke St. Jude, when I feel I'm a lost cause or a hopeless case! Always remember there's a saint for every cause!!! Have a blessed and saintly week!

## **Refugee Sponsorship**

Our parish has begun the process of sponsoring a Refugee Family. We are one of several parishes in our Diocese who are stepping up to the plate. The Diocese of St. Catharines is a Sponsorship Agreement Holder (SAH). The agreement is with the Government of Canada, Department of Citizenship and Immigration. As an SAH, the Diocese is able to sponsor refugees, and has done so for decades. Under the terms of the SAH, the Diocese is willing to authorize "constituent groups", eg. parishes to undertake refugee sponsorship. To help ease some concerns, the refugees that will be coming to Canada are screened and processed by the UN, and then submitted for screening, processing and approval by Canada Immigration. Any refugees who are approved and who enter through this channel will have received all immunizations, vaccinations, a "Landed Immigrant Status," [meaning they can find employment and also be enrolled in health care.] Our role as a parish will be to take care of the family's needs for a period one year. This includes housing (apartment), utilities, bus transportation, food, clothing, etc. For a family of four this would be approximately \$27-\$30,000.00. So what we need to do now is ask our parishioners to assist with this mission. "I was a stranger and you welcomed me."- Matthew 25:35!!! If you can donate, please make cheques payable to ST. PATRICKS- REFUGEE SPONSORSHIP. Once we have raised the required amount, we will receive notification when a family is available. There's already some families waiting!!! God bless you for your generosity!
