Dear Friends,

We have just had a glorious week of weather! It's great to see people still wearing their summer attire! Praise God. This Monday is November 11th... *Remembrance Day- Armistice Day*. May we take the sacred time to remember those who served our country in the World Wars and



Conflicts, those who paid the ultimate sacrifice with their lives, and those who were injured physically and emotionally... all for our freedom. We pray for those who currently serve our country in the peace-keeping missions around the world. *Lest we Forget!*

Today's readings are about "Trusting in God." In The Book of Kings, a widow gives her last morsel of food to Elijah... and because of her trust and generosity, God provides for her and her son in a time of famine. Her jar of meal was not emptied, nor did her jug of oil run out. In the Gospel, Jesus observes people putting large sums into the Temple Treasury... and then he sees a widow putting in two copper coins. 
