Today we celebrate the 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time! Our Church Year is winding down. Temperatures are getting colder... and the leaves are going fast! Thanks to the heavy wind on Tuesday, I stood and watched all the parish leaves blow down Queen Street! We'll save the leaf bags for next year!!!



Today is November 11th... *Remembrance Day-Armistice Day*. May we take the sacred time to remember all those who served our country in the World Wars, those who paid the ultimate sacrifice with their lives, and those who were injured physically and

emotionally... all for our freedom. We pray for those who currently serve our country in the peace-keeping missions around the world. *Lest we Forget!* 

In today's readings we see what **Trusting in God** is all about. In The Book of Kings, a widow gives her last morsel of food to Elijah the Prophet (Father of the Carmelites)!!!... and because of her trust and generosity, God provides for her and her son in a time of famine. # Invitation to Help the Homeless

An overnight warming shelter to protect people living on the street has opened in Niagara Falls. It is operating out of St. Andrew's United Church, 5645 Morrison St., as a two-year pilot project overseen by Niagara Region but run through Project Share. It is set up to accommodate 15 people every night, from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., through to March 31. If any parishioners or parish organizations would like to volunteer, there are many opportunities to help! Volunteers are needed to help staff greet guests in the evening, show them to their area, make and serve coffee, provide a snack. If residents want a game of cards or a conversation volunteers could engage with them if they are comfortable. If there are early risers, volunteers could help with wake up at 6 am, prepare coffee and snacks, distribute bus tickets. Or help with clean-up after 7 am. If you are interested, please let the parish office know, and we will put you in touch with the coordinator. If you are not able to give time we are collecting boots, shoes, men's mitts and gloves, feminine hygiene products and cleaning products for the church like bleach, spray disinfectant and wipes. These can be dropped off at St. Pat's Parish Office or next to the Project Share Bins in the Church!
