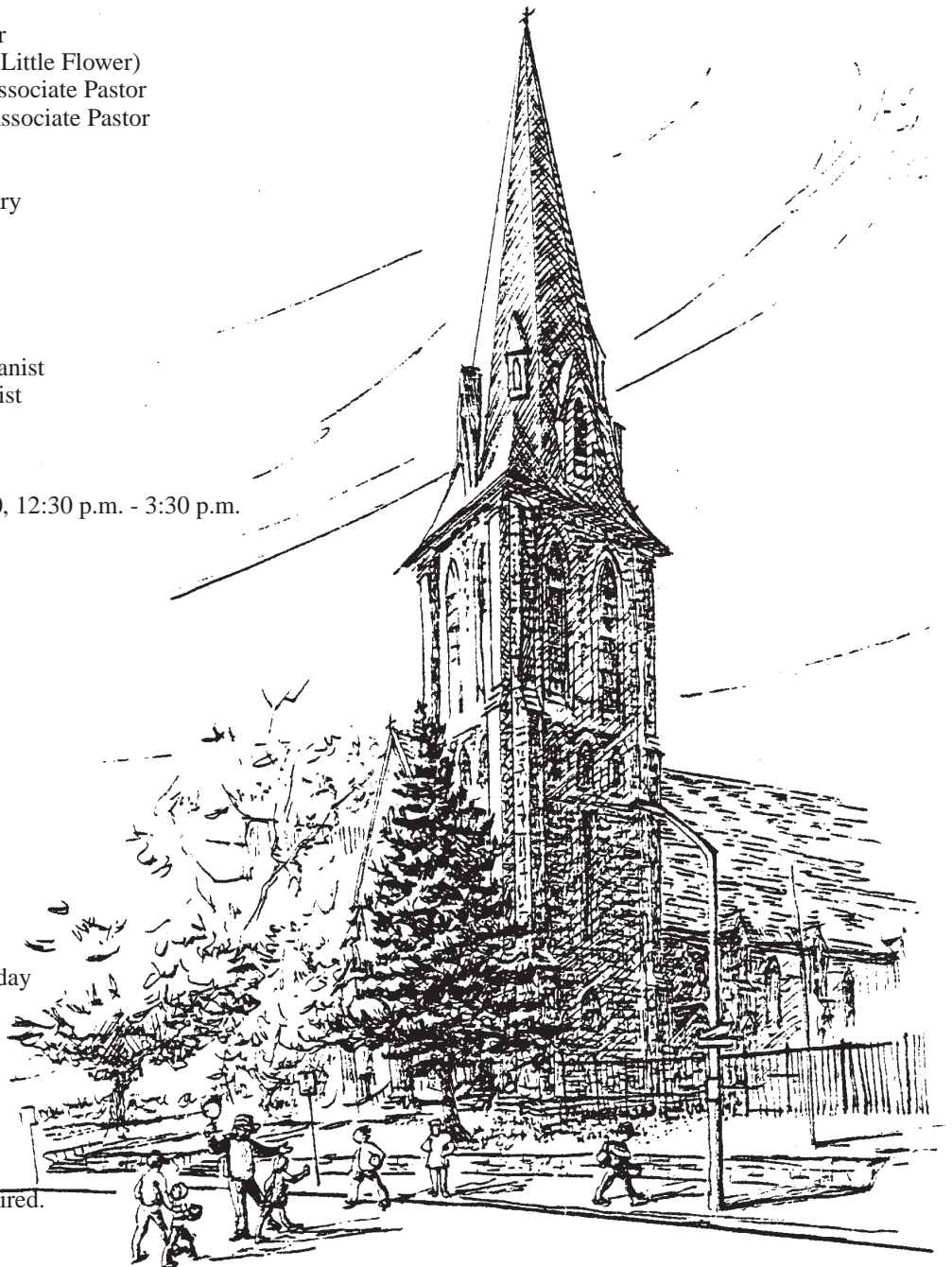

Baptisms will be celebrated in St. Patrick Church at 1:00 PM on:

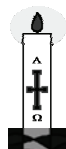
Sunday, November 23. A mandatory meeting for Parents & Godparents will be held in the Church on Tuesday, November 11 at 7:00 pm.
