

It was wonderful having eleven of my siblings and nieces here for the long weekend (Wednesday to Tuesday). They thoroughly enjoyed our parish and our parishioners. Many thanks for your hospitality and kindness to them... from pizzas, to cookies, to cakes, to gifts, to car rides!

Our Church year is coming to an end. Next Sunday is Christ the King!!! And then, Advent. This time of year, our scriptures always address the end times. St. Paul says that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night, and he urges us to keep awake and be sober! He also tells us to live as children of the light.

In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus addresses the end times, in the *Parable of the Talents*. The master entrusts his possessions to three of his servants, and then goes on a journey. When he returns he calls them in! He rewards the first two who had invested well... and he punishes the third who buried the talent in the ground. Matthew says, about the day and hour of the coming of the Son of Man... no one knows only the Father. When the time comes for each of us to meet our God face to face, it will be great to hear God say, "Well done, good and trustworthy servant... enter into the joy of your master!"



Who will share in the Master's joy? Will you? Will I? I'm sure it will be those who do God's work here on earth; those who are faithful to God and God's people; those who have a good relationship with God, those who truly make sacrifices for the poor. It doesn't hurt to

ask, What must I do to be more fully prepared for the coming of the Lord? We have a responsibility to God to take the life that he has given us, treasure it, develop it, celebrate it, share it, and set the world on fire with His Love. As the Church year winds down, we can ask ourselves, What am I doing with everything I have been given... my time, my talents, my treasures! May we have the courage to be fully Christian, fully alive, and more than prepared ... when the Lord comes! Have a blessed week.

Today is World Day of the Poor

At the conclusion of the Jubilee of Mercy, I wanted to offer the Church a World Day of the Poor, so that throughout the world Christian communities can become an ever greater sign of Christ's charity for the least and those most in need. To the World Days instituted by my Predecessors, which are already a tradition in the life of our communities, I wish to add this one, which adds to them an exquisitely evangelical fullness, that is, Jesus' preferential love for the poor.

I invite the whole Church, and men and women of good will everywhere, to turn their gaze on this day to all those who stretch out their hands and plead for our help and solidarity. They are our brothers and sisters, created and loved by the one Heavenly Father. This Day is meant, above all, to encourage believers to react against a culture of discard and waste, and to embrace the culture of encounter.

This new World Day, therefore, should become a powerful appeal to our consciences as believers, allowing us to grow in the conviction that sharing with the poor enables us to understand the deepest truth of the Gospel. The poor are not a problem: they are a resource from which to draw as we strive to accept and practice in our lives the essence of the Gospel. (Pope Francis)
