

Dear Friends:

Welcome to November. This can be a somber month. The beautiful colours of autumn will quickly give in to the starkness of winter. With the time change, and as the month progresses, the days will get shorter and darkness will make its presence felt. But we never lose hope, because all will burst forth again in the spring. November is the month when we remember our deceased loved ones. It's often called the "Month of the Dead"; "November to Remember". Today is the Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed (All Soul's Day). It doesn't fall on Sunday very often.

I've sure most of us have experienced personal losses. People who have journeyed with us, who gave us love and whom we loved in return, have been called home to God. This is a day and this is a month when we remember them, and all our loved ones. We have a Nine-Day Novena of Masses for All Souls beginning today. On Sunday evening we will have a special All Soul's Mass, in which we remember our loved ones who died over the past year. We also take the time during this month to write the names of our loved ones in the Book of Life. These are beautiful ways to remember them. We pause this day and throughout this month to give thanks for their lives, to pray for them, and to ask them to pray for us.

As we pray in Eucharistic Prayer II:

"Remember ... our brothers and sisters who have fallen asleep in the hope of the resurrection, and all who have died in your mercy, welcome them into the light of your face."

Have a blessed All Soul's Day and a blessed Month of November.
