Update on Church Roof and Accessible Door

We have finally contracted a company from Toronto to do an in depth inspection of our church roof. There are very few companies out there that work with slate. As soon as there's a break in the weather, *Semple Gooder Roofing Inc.* will be here with a lift. They will remove slate from several sections and examine the decking. They will also check the decking on the section where we have been losing slate. In September, we had a local company install an aluminum barrier in the gutters to prevent slate from coming onto the parking lot. We had an unfortunate mishap last Saturday, when a snow plow hit the corner of the accessible entrance of the church. Emergency repairs to prevent water damage and to ease the opening/closing of the door are in process, but the main repairs (interior/exterior) will have to be done in the spring. Never a dull moment.


