

As difficult as it is to use the word "happy" these days, we still have to say, Happy New Church Year! Welcome to the *Season of Advent*! Our church will be dressed in purple for the next four weeks! Jesus' words in today's Gospel sets the theme for Advent... and for

our Christian lives, *Be alert at all times praying that you may have the strength... to stand before the Son of Man!*

The first candle will be lit on our Advent Wreath, and this sets us on a four week journey toward Christmas! We wait, watch and prepare, not only for Christmas Day, but ultimately for the Lord's Second Coming.
