Dear Friends,

November is here! On Thursday we celebrated All Saint's Day, and on Friday, All Soul's Day. On **All Soul's Day**, we remembered all those gone before us in faith. We celebrated a special Memorial Mass on Friday night, during which we remembered those who died in our parish this past year. It was truly a healing and uplifting celebration.

The month of November is a time to pray for our deceased. A Nine-Day Novena of Masses is celebrated at St. Pat's, beginning on All Soul's Day. This is a beautiful way to remember our loved ones. Special envelopes for this Novena are at the doors of the church. There is a *Book of Life* in the sanctuary to write the names of our beloved dead. They will be remembered at all Masses, Rosaries and Prayers at St. Pat's during this month.

One of the greatest things we can do for those who have died, is to pray for them, to always remember them in prayer. That's why we have special Mass intentions. Every time I pass a cemetery, I make the sign of



the cross and pray, "Eternal rest grant unto them..." My father always told me and constantly reminded me to pray for him, and to have Masses for him after death. I am faithful to dad's wish every day. He also taught me to pray for those

who have no one left to pray for them. I will never forget to do that either.

All our beloved dead **still need** our prayers. I am sure that very few human beings go directly into heaven at the time of death. There still has to be a purging **(purification)** before we can experience the beatific vision of God, meeting God face to face! That's why our Church teaches in her Catechism, "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven."

So, let us never forget to pray for the dead, and to assist them on their heavenly journey with Mass Intentions, our prayers. And of course, may we do our best on this side, to lead lives worthy of the Kingdom of Heaven! If we want to know how... well today's Gospel gives us the answer! Love the Lord your God will all your heart, soul, mind and strength; and love your neighbour as yourself! Have a blessed week.
