Or when I visit a grave, I pray that prayer. Every time I hear that someone has died, I pray that prayer. Every Christian should know that prayer off by heart. Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls, and all the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.
