


A mandatory meeting for Parents & Godparents will be held in the Church on Tuesday, November 11 at 7:00 pm.

Dear Friends:

This past Sunday evening we gathered at a special Mass, with the family members of those who lost a loved one over the past year. It was our *All Souls Memorial Mass*, certainly a very moving liturgy. Our Adult Choir with Carol and Sandra were accompanied by John Arnold on the trumpet! They lifted the rafters with beautiful hymns of comfort and praise! Thank you for a spectacular ministry! As I looked around the church during the Mass, I could see the loneliness, pain and tears on many faces. There's something so sacred about having a loved one's name proclaimed, and then a bell rung, and a candle lit in their honour! Dealing with a family death is never easy! But we Christians grieve in a different way! We grieve with the hope that one day we shall see our loved ones again. The death and resurrection of Jesus is our source of hope. I feel sorry for those who have no faith, or who do not believe in life after death. To face a death with that stark finality is so empty and painful. Praise God for our faith, even if it gets shaken at times.

Today is the Feast of **The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica**. It may seem like an odd feast to celebrate on a Sunday, but let me explain!



Most Catholics think of St. Peter's as the Pope's main church, but not so. **St. John Lateran** is the Pope's church, the cathedral of the Diocese of Rome where the Bishop of Rome presides. The first basilica on the site was built in the 4th century when Constantine donated land and a palace, he had received from the wealthy Laterani family. That structure and successive structures suffered fire, earthquake and the ravages of war! Pope Innocent X commissioned the present building in 1646. One of Rome's most imposing churches, the Lateran's towering facade is crowned with statues of Christ, John the Baptist, John the Evangelist and 12 doctors of the Church. Beneath its high altar rests the remains of the small wooden table on which tradition holds, St. Peter celebrated Mass.

Unlike the commemoration of other churches, this anniversary is a feast. St. John Lateran is, in a sense, **the parish church of all Catholics**, for it is the Pope's parish, the Cathedral Church of the Bishop of Rome. It's our feast too! As we celebrate the *Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica* this Sunday, we can also celebrate our own Church... our own Parish of St. Patrick! We are the **People of God**, temples of the Holy Spirit built of Living Stones, and our call is to go forth from the altar of St. Pat's to the altar of the world and spread God's peace, justice, mercy, joy and love!
