

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends,

I hope everyone enjoyed Thanksgiving Weekend! I was reminded by the children at our School Mass this past Tuesday, of the many things we need to thank God for! The kids mentioned, family, houses, water, food, God, pets, soap, friends, and the list of big and small things went on and on! May we never take for granted what we have, or what we enjoy here in Canada. Thanks to all of you who came out for the Blessing of Animals last Sunday. It was a huge and happy gathering of families and pets!



In today's Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples a parable about their need *to pray always and not to lose heart!* He tells of a widow who consistently asks a harsh judge to grant her justice. She will not relent. She hounds him, and in the end her request is granted! The Gospel ends with a guestion,

"...when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?" We know very well what he will find happening around the world... painful and sad indeed.

But, will he find us **persevering** in prayer and faith. We need to pray constantly. Morning, noon and night. How many people give up on prayer when the prayer seems to go unanswered? The most powerful of all prayers, I believe, is the "Our Father!" In that prayer we are telling God to "let His will be done!" Not mine, His will! And that's a very trusting thing. It's called surrendering! That's putting God in control. Because God always knows what's best for us.

My experience is that it's the people who are constant in prayer, have good prayer habits, who are the ones who easily accept God's Will! We can be experts at telling God everything we need. The problem is, we do all the talking. Have we ever truly listened to God? That takes practice. Someone once said, *God gave us two ears and one mouth, so we should listen twice as much as we speak*. To be a good listener calls for attentiveness, quietness, stillness..., certainly a commodity these days! God speaks very clearly...it's us who need to work on our listening! God also speaks to us through other people. May God give us the strength to deepen our prayer lives. Can we make it a daily practice? Oh God, give us the courage to pray, the courage to let you be God, and the courage to accept your holy Will! Have a prayerful week!

Our story and fruits of our sharing will be written and presented at the next Diocesan Discernment Group Meeting. Some questions we will look at are: Why did St. Patrick Parish come into existence? What were the needs at the time? Have those needs changed? What generated energy? What do we want to celebrate about our parish story? Who, individuals or groups, assist us to be true to our mission? What impact have we had upon the civic community? Please call the parish office if you plan on attending, as we will prepare some refreshments!

Use of Parish Facilities

Please note that our Insurance Company (Catholic Mutual Canada) recently completed an extensive Audit of our Parish and Buildings, etc. They were quite impressed at how well everything is maintained and up-dated, and up to code. During this audit, we were notified of a new

policy. As you may know, St. Patrick Parish does not rent our facilities, nor do we carry a rental insurance. Our parish has never needed this option to survive. Praise God! Our facilities have always been made available for regular parishioners, with a donation. This will no longer be possible. Anyone using the Hall, Gym or any Parish Facility for non-parish events, must carry an insurance for such an event... and a certificate of insurance must be provided. The cost will vary depending on the nature of the event, the size of the gathering, or the use/non-use of alcohol. This can be done simply through contacting your homeowners insurance, for a one-time event, or on-going event. We also have at our disposal, an insurance company provided through the Diocese. For example, a Baby Shower with 25-40 persons, may cost \$30. The parish office can assist you when you inquire about the use of our facilities.
