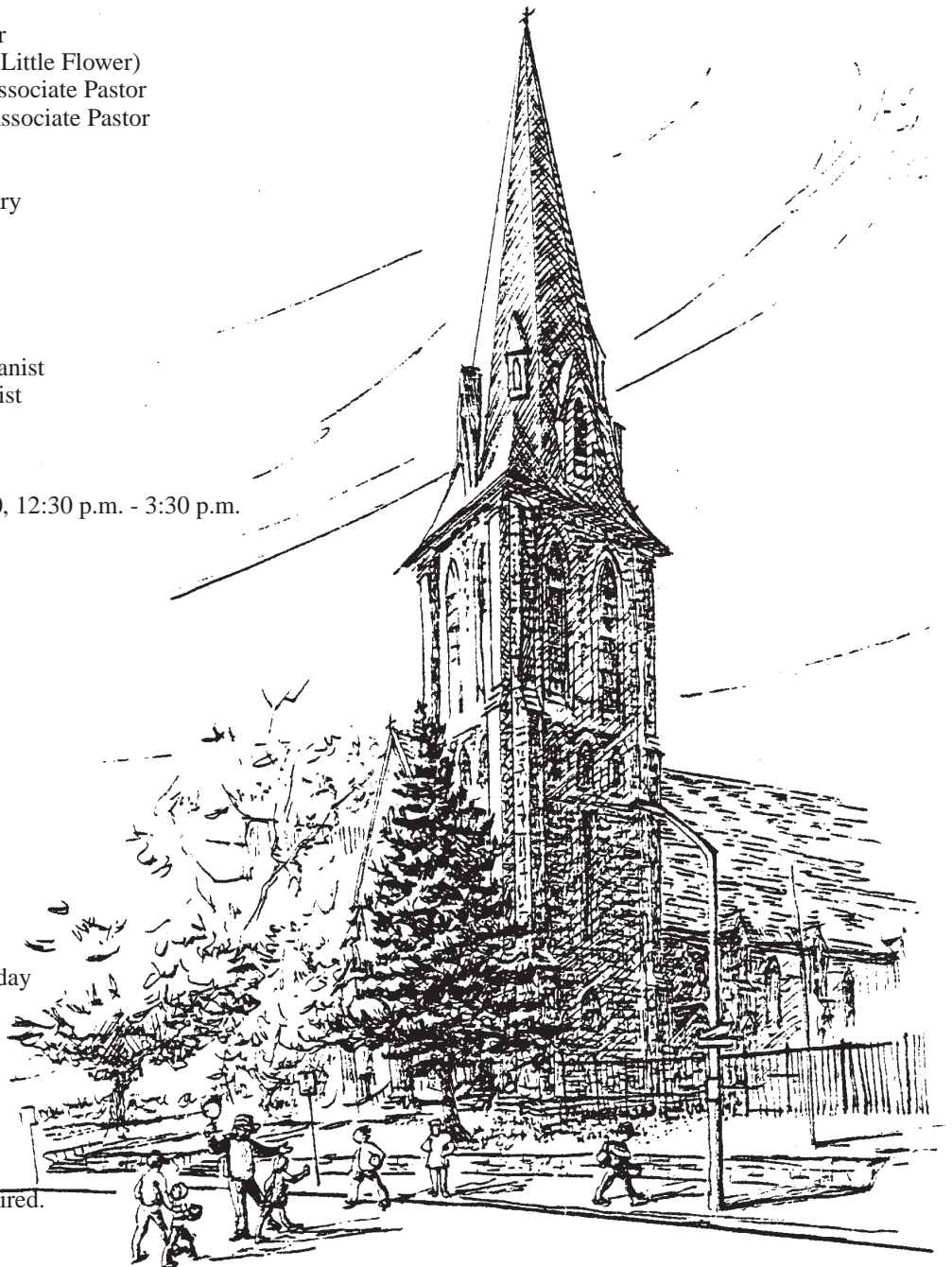

Dear Friends:

Today is the 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time. This Sunday we welcome over 30 Confirmation Candidates at the 9:30 AM Mass. As part of their preparation for Confirmation, they will make a public commitment to the community. And we also commit to these young adults that we will be there to support them on their faith journey. Confirmation will be celebrated here at St. Patrick's on Saturday, November 15th at the 5:00 PM Mass.

In today's Gospel, we have a *Pharisee* and a *Tax-Collector* praying to God in the Temple. The self-righteous *Pharisee* presents himself in his goodness, full of self-flattery... not asking for God's mercy and blessing. He puts others down, thanking God that he's not like other people, thieves, rogues, adulterers, and even this tax collector. And of course, he leaves with nothing but his own pompous spiritual arrogance. In his own mind, he doesn't need God's mercy. He is just too good!

The **tax collector** is standing far-off, couldn't even look up to heaven. He beat his breast, in his **suit of sinfulness**, AND he knows it! He prays, not to himself, like the Pharisee, but to God and with words reflecting his naked truth. **"God, be merciful to me a sinner!"** The tax collector was the one who went home justified. "Those who humble themselves will be exalted!" He judged no one, but himself! Who am I in this parable? A good week to look at ourselves. Maybe remove any masks or trappings of pretense. It's so easy to admire ourselves... even judge others. It's only when we humble ourselves, and get in touch with our sin, will we ever know the freeing touch of God's mercy!

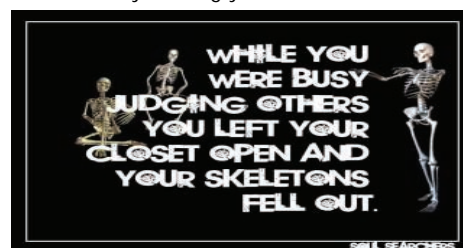
