### Dear Friends,

We hear again from St. James in this Sunday's 2<sup>nd</sup> reading. James was very hands-on and practical when it came to putting the Gospel into action. In these short verses (2:14-18), he addresses the **HOW** of our faith. He reminds us that **WORKS** are important! Faith **WITHOUT** works is **DEAD**. He gives an example of a person having no food or clothing and we say, "Go in peace; keep warm and eat your fill,"... and we do nothing to meet their bodily needs! Wrong, says James! "By my works, I will show you my faith!!!" People of faith are people who reach out to others. This requires **sacrifice**. This is what Jesus means when he tells his disciples in today's Gospel, to "take up your cross, deny yourselves, and follow me."

Being Christian is not only about **me and Jesus!** Christianity is about Jesus Christ, YES. But to follow Him means we are to imitate Him, be like Him. We can't call ourselves Christian and refuse to live the Christian way. We must have a Christian attitude at all times! A sacrificial love, a sacrificial heart, always ready to hear the cries of those around us, to answer to the needs of the less fortunate. And this parish of St. Pat's do that so well. But we can always do more!

How can we concretely and practically and pro-actively put flesh on that this week? If we're out grocery shopping, maybe pick up a couple of food items for *Project Share*. Maybe when we pass the St. Vincent de Paul Box this weekend, we'll empty the coins from our pockets. If everyone did this, we could feed a few more people in our town. Maybe we can pick up some juices or cereal bars for our Breakfast Program! Maybe we can pick up some Tim Hortons cards so we can have them on hand to give those who need something to eat and drink right away. Maybe we can clean out our clothes closet, and give away the things we haven't worn in a while. These are practical things we can do. And they are Christ-like. May we have the courage to be more Christian this week!
