

## FROM THE PASTOR

#### Dear Friends,

Our scripture readings this weekend address something that we all have to deal with as we journey through life: **FORGIVENESS**. It's been an issue as long as we've had humans on the earth! The Book of Sirach reminds us of the effects that anger, and vengeance can have on us. They violate our covenant with God and destroy us. "Forgive the wrong that is done, and then your sins will be pardoned when you pray," says Sirach. That sounds like Jesus' words in the Our Father prayer!

Today's Gospel deals with the same issue when Peter asks Jesus, "How often should I forgive my brother or sister if they sin against me? As




many as seven times?" Jesus replied, "Not seven times but seventy- seven times!" Jesus went on to tell a parable about a servant who had his debts (10,000 talents)

forgiven by a king. The servant then went out and refused to forgive a fellow slave who owed him 100 denarii. How ruthless. How selfish. How hypocritical! When the king heard this he threw the man in jail until he paid his entire debt!

How easy do I forgive? What does resentment do to us? It destroys us!!! Even destroys our relationship with God, and others. There's a story about a big proud expensive yacht that was tied in a harbour in a poor town. The big fancy yacht began pulling away from the pier. But... someone forgot to untie one of the lines from the dock. The result? The stern of the ship could not pull away until either the rope busted or the stern was pulled off. The rope won! The whole back of the luxurious yacht was shattered! Something was holding it back, something was causing it to destroy itself. That's what anger does to us. That's what refusing to forgive, does to us. It destroys us.

We've all been offended by others. I sure have offended some people. And I have also been hurt by others. But, you know, we have a choice. We can get angry and nurse that anger for a long time, and let it grow into deep resentment and hatred. Or we can nip it in the bud early on, and make amends. What has someone done to me that has had a negative effect on my life? What are my personal battle stories? Against whom do I harbour resentments? What have I done that I can't forgive myself for? These are deeply spiritual questions. The past is past. Maybe a great week to untie the stern rope, and move freely out into the ocean of life, in one piece! Let Go and Let God! Who needs my hand in forgiveness... in reconciliation... this week? Who needs to hear me say, "I'm sorry," or "I was wrong," or "I forgive you?" Let this be a week to bring peace and unity and Gospel love back into our souls and back into our families. Have a blessed and healing week! I'll pray for you, and you pray for me.
