Dear Friends,

Welcome to Autumn! A new season! Before long, our leaves will be changing and falling! Thanksgiving is just around the corner! Time flies. The only constant in everything, is God!

This Sunday, with great joy, we welcome Fr. Paul Henson, O.Carm. here with us. He is the Vocation Director for the Carmelites! Fr. Paul will

Ordained Ministers - who gather the prayers and longing of your people, who serve as a channel of your presence through the sacraments.


Religious sisters, brothers, and priests - whose life in community foreshadows our eternal unity in Christ,
