Dear Friends:

Today is the 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time. We are officially into the season of autumn! And there's already signs of change out there. The trees are beginning to turn colour.

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells the parable about *Lazarus and the Rich Man*. It is addressed to the Pharisees, because of their lack of concern for the poor. A rich man (unnamed), who lived lavishly his entire life, ignored a poor man (Lazarus), who lay at his gate. He probably walked over him.
