

23rd Sunday, September 5, 2021

In our first reading today the Prophet Isaiah tells those who have a fearful heart to be strong, do not fear, for the eyes of the blind will be opened, the ears of the deaf unstopped, the lame will leap like a deer and the tongue of the mute will sing for joy. And of course this passage comes to fulfillment in today's gospel with the healing of the deaf and mute man. Imagine being able to hear and speak for the first time? With God everything is possible. There's a need for all of us to keep our ears open to hear the cries around us, especially those who hunger for food, who lack shelter, the homeless, persons with mental disabilities, persons with addictions. And then upon hearing their cries, we are called to speak up for them. Give them a voice. This is how miracles happen 2000 years after Christ. This is what it means to be a follower.

24th Sunday, September 12, 2021

In today's gospel Jesus asked his disciples, "Who do you say that I am?" And Peter answers, "You are the Christ."
