THE HOLY WEEK LITURGY

Today, on **Palm Sunday** we begin **Holy Week -** the most solemn celebrations of the mysteries of our faith. This coming week truly is a *Holy Week*.

Holy Thursday – we celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper. On this night, Our Lord instituted the sacraments of Holy Eucharist and Holy Orders. Holy Thursday marks the beginning of the *Three Days* or *Triduum* of special liturgical prayer.

Good Friday – we commemorate Christ's self-giving Love for us, His suffering and death on the Cross. The liturgy consists of three parts: *the liturgy of the Word*, *the veneration of the Cross, and the reception of Holy Communion*. This is the only day during the year when we do not celebrate the Eucharist. Good Friday is a day of abstinence and fasting.

Easter Vigil – is the most solemn memorial of the Liturgical Year. We keep watch and celebrate the Resurrection of Christ in the sacraments in four parts: the *Service of Light*, the *Liturgy of the Word*, *Christian Initiation, and the Liturgy of the Eucharist*. The Easter Vigil does not correspond to the usual Saturday evening Mass. On this night we will welcome 22 adults & 6 children as full members of the Catholic Church.

ALL DAY CONFESSIONS Wednesday, April 16th

The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available from 8 am to 8 pm. Mass will be at 12:15. Confessions will pause during Mass then will continue until 8:00 pm. The schedule of priests is posted on our website.

Examination of Conscience

Before celebrating the Sacrament of Penance, one should prepare oneself with an examination of conscience, which involves reflecting prayerfully on one's thoughts, words, and deeds. There are various types of examinations of conscience but regardless of which one we use it should be rooted in Scripture; the Ten Commandments and Beatitudes. Below is a link with a few examples of examinations of conscience that can help us prepare for the Sacrament. What is Eucharistic Adoration?

Eucharistic Adoration is a special prayer in which we adore or honor the Presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. It involves "the contemplation of the Mystery of Christ truly present before us." During Eucharistic Adoration, we pray or remain "silent." We open ourselves to God's Graces which flow from the Eucharist.
