Weekly Gospel Reflection (Mt 2: 13-15, 19-23)



Pope Benedict XVI points out that the first witnesses of Christ's birth, the shepherds, found themselves not only before the Infant Jesus but also a small family: mother, father, and newborn son. God had chosen to reveal himself by being born into a human family and the human family thus became an icon of God!

SOLEMNITY OF MARY THE MOTHER OF GOD

Cardinal Cantalamessa: “*Mary is the Mother of God not only because she carried him in her womb physically but also because she first conceived him in her heart, with faith. ... we can imitate her in the sense of her faith. Jesus was the first to apply this title of ‘Mother of Christ’ to the Church when he said: ‘My mother and my brothers are those who hear the word of God and put it into practice’ (Lk 8:21).*”

St. Francis of Assisi: *WE ARE MOTHERS OF CHRIST WHEN WE CARRY HIM IN OUR HEART and in our body by divine love and with a pure and sincere conscience; we give birth to him through holy works, which should shine forth as an example for others.*

Holy Days of Obligation in Canada

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops has decreed that the Holy Days of obligation to be observed in Canada are all Sundays of the year, **Christmas Day**, and the **Solemnity of Mary the Mother of God** (January 1st).
