FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Sunday's Gospel Reflection (Lk 5:1-11)



Peter falls at Jesus' feet and says that he is not worthy to be in Jesus' presence. This detail reminds us of Isaiah's reaction when he encountered God. Isaiah expressed his human limitations in terms of unclean lips. To Isaiah the seraph says, "**your guilt has departed**, **and your sin is blotted out** (Is 6:1-8)." To Peter Jesus says, "**Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching people**."

Both stories show that when we allow God to embrace us in His mercy, God will transcend our human limitations and sins to prepare us for the task to which we are being called. Therefore, when God asks, "*Whom shall I send?*" each of us can answer, "*Send me!*"
