## BAPTISM OF THE LORD

**Sunday January 11<sup>th</sup>**

This feast of the Baptism of Our Lord, according to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, signifies Jesus's acceptance of his mission as God's suffering Servant; who allows himself to be numbered among sinful men, although he is the Lamb of God that takes away the sin of the world. By his baptism, he is coming to "fulfill all righteousness," that is, completely submitting himself out of love for us to the Father's will (CCC, 536). His birth on Christmas is a preparation of his death on Good Friday, his baptism today points to his baptism of death for the remission of our sins. Hence, at that moment of his baptism, the heavens open and the Father proclaims his delight in his Son (Lk 3:22).
