THE FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD. Friday, February 2nd Mass at 8:00 am <u>and 7:00 pm</u>

This feast day celebrates the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple. 'Together with Simeon and Anna, we contemplate the Divine child, the Word made flesh, who is brought to the Temple: the Temple of our hearts.' The feast is also called **Candlemas** for the custom of blessing and using lighted candles. February 2nd is also the **World Day for Consecrated Life**. It is a special day to pray for the religious women and men and all God's people who "follow Christ by means of the practice of the evangelical counsels."

Please bring candles from home that you wish to have blessed. Candles for the Presentation of the Lord will be also available for purchase in the narthex.



Feast of St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr, and the Blessing of Throats

Blaise is best known for the tradition of blessing throats linked to him. ... Blaise has long been associated with cures for afflictions of the throat, and the blessing of throats may take place on his feast day (February 3) or any time during the year (see, Exert from Living with Christ). Next weekend at the end of all Masses we will have the Blessing of Throats.

What is the difference between sacraments and sacramentals-blessings?

A **sacrament** is a visible sign of an invisible grace. Jesus instituted seven of them, and they are gifts from Him to His Church. They convey grace. Blessings are called "**sacramentals**" because they prepare us to receive the grace of the sacraments and help us to grow to be more like Christ (see, *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, no. 1131 and 1670).
