# **Covid Update from the Diocese of Hamilton**

As announced by Premier Ford, the Province is moving into step 3 of the reopening plan effective July 16, 2021. Unlike the previous steps (1 and 2), there is no set percent capacity for religious services, rites or ceremonies. However, all persons must be able to maintain physical distancing guidelines of a least two metres from every other person (except their caregiver and members of their household) and must comply with public health guidance for wearing masks and using hand sanitizer.

For St. Michael Parish, this will keep our limits around 30% or 210 people in the main part of the church. We do have an additional seating capacity of 80 in the parish hall.
