Solemnity, Nativity of Saint John the Baptist - June 24, 2024

The birth of John the Baptist was one of the earliest feasts to be named to a particular day on the Church calendar. June 24 was chosen as it is six months before the birth of Christ. With its proximity to the summer solstice, it signifies the waning of the light, while the birth of Jesus near the winter solstice marks the coming of the light. (*livingwithchrist.ca*)

Solemnity, Saint Peter and Saint Paul - June 29, 2024

Tradition says these two apostles ... were martyred in Rome. Peter, a fisherman, was chosen by Jesus to be his disciple. ... Jesus changed Simon's name to Peter and told him that it was on this rock (*petra*) that he would build his Church. ... From the middle of the 3rd century onward, documents show that the bishops of Rome were recognized as the successors of Peter. Paul's experience of the risen Christ resulted in his conversion from a zealous persecutor of Christians to an apostle ... Paul called himself the "Apostle of the Gentiles." Growing Faith in the Summer Months - READ ONE OF THE FOUR GOSPELS

St. Jerome said, "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ." Aside from the Eucharist and our daily life of prayer, there is no more certain way to grow in knowledge and love of Jesus than to read the word of God. Jesus is himself the Word made flesh, so every word of the Bible speaks of him in some way. But the Gospels in a particular way allow us to encounter the person of Christ in an intense and vivid way.
