THE FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Advent (from Latin *adventus*, "coming"), is a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to Christ's second coming at the end of time and to the anniversary of Our Lord's birth on Christmas. Our Advent scripture readings help us to recognize that Christ comes into our lives in many ways at the present time.

Today, on the First Sunday of Advent we begin a new Liturgical Year. We move into the "Year A" cycle of readings. The Gospel – on most Sundays – will be taken from the Gospel of Matthew.

Is Advent a "penitential season"?

The liturgical season of Advent is not strictly a penitential season as is Lent. The Code of Canon Law affirms this, stating, "The penitential days and times in the universal Church are every Friday of the whole year and the season of Lent" (Ca.1250). However, Advent also includes an element of penance in the sense that we are called to constant conversion. Conversion is an ongoing aspect of the Christian life. The conversion we are called to in Advent has a distinctive character: one of *joyful hope*, of preparing, quieting, and disciplining our hearts for the full joy of Christmas.
